

In accordance with CDC guidelines: If you believe you were exposed, you should <u>quarantine at home for 5 days before testing</u> and wear a mask around others. If you test positive, you should quarantine at home for a minimum of 5 days. If you have no symptoms, or if your symptoms are resolving, you can leave your house after 5 days, but should continue to wear a mask around others and socially distance for an additional 5 days. If you test positive, but cannot quarantine at home, you should wear a mask around others and socially distance for 10 days.
